

Student Feedback - B. COM Programme





Student Feedback B. COM (Mean Score)




Student Feedback B.Sc. Mathematics (Mean Score)







Student Feedback M.A. History (Mean Score)





PGDCA Student Feedback (Mean Score)



The matter is informed to the higher authority for improvement. From this session a new library teacher is recruited by higher education department. So, problem will no longer continue in future and it will be helpful to teachers.
